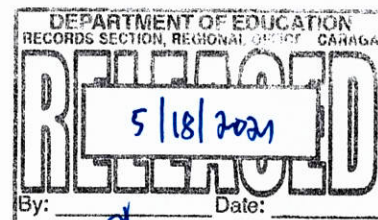

**SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM EVALUATION AND FEEDBACK
SURVEY**

Financial Assistance shall be downloaded to the twelve Schools Division Offices for the communication expenses (SMS/calls & internet load) of the participants for use of SDO Focal Persons to coordinate and administer/disseminate the survey relative to the conduct of SBFP Evaluation and Feedback Survey.

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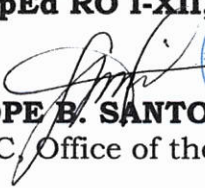

SUBJECT: **CONDUCT OF THE EVALUATION AND FEEDBACK ONLINE SURVEY ON THE SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP)**

DATE : **13 April 2021**

This Bureau through the School Health Division (SHD) shall conduct an Evaluation and Feedback Survey (EFS) on the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) which aims to gather feedback from the parents and/or guardians of the beneficiaries and the field implementers on the implementation of SBFP for SY 2020-2021 and their perceived benefits to the program recipients.

The objectives of the School-Based Feeding Program Evaluation and Feedback Survey are to:

- a) Obtain the parents'/guardians' perception on the effects of the program to the beneficiaries who received Nutritious Food Products (NFP) and Fresh/Sterilized Milk;
- b) Gather the school feeding coordinators' feedback on the management and the implementation of the program;
- c) Gather the parents'/guardians' satisfaction/acceptance of the program
- d) Identify the issues and concerns that may be associated with the implementation of the program; and
- e) Identify areas for improvement and recommend action plans.

There will be two sets of questionnaires, one intended for the parents and/or guardians, and another one for the school feeding coordinators in recipient schools. These surveys are thru Google Forms, and can be accessed through the following link:

In line with this, there will be a Virtual Conference that will be held on May 3, 2021 via Google Meet from 8:30 am to 3:00 pm. The participants to this activity are the Regional and Schools Division Focal Persons. The said activity aims to: 1) present the Evaluation and Feedback Survey questionnaires; 2) discuss and orient the Regional and Schools Division Focal Person on the methodology of the said survey and the date of its administration; and 3) discuss and prepare logistics on how the two survey questionnaires will be disseminated.

Expected participants are respectfully requested to attend the conference and register at (<http://bit.ly/Virtual-EFS>) prior to the scheduled date. Certificate of Participation will be given thru DepEd PD-LMS (<https://training.deped.gov.ph>) and the ENROLMENT KEY will be announced before the end of the activity.

It is also requested that participants be allowed to claim communication expenses per DO No. 38, s. 2020 and meal reimbursements chargeable against SBFP Program Support Funds in accordance with existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
