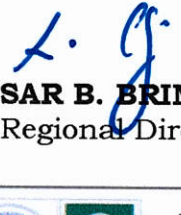

SEAMEO INNOTECH'S ONLINE VERSION OF THE SOUTHEAST ASIAN SCHOOL
LEADERSHIP IN PROGRAM (SEA-SLP)

1. In reference to Memorandum no. DM-CI-2020-00253 from the Undersecretary Diosdado M. San Antonio of Curriculum and Instruction, the Southeast Asian Minister of Education - Regional center for Education Innovation and Technology (SEAMEO INNOTECH) calls for nomination on its Online Version of the Southeast Asian School Leadership Program (SEA-SLP) for school heads which will run from **January 23 to March 5, 2021**.
2. Schools Divisions Offices shall nominate **one (1) school head from primary schools** and **one (1) from the secondary schools** who possess the following qualification:
 - a. Must be 50 years old below;
 - b. At least five (5) years' experience as a school head;
 - c. Must have no pending administrative and/or criminal case;
 - d. Must have no pending nomination for scholarship in another program/course or have already rendered the required service obligation for a scholarship previously enjoyed;
 - e. Must be computer literate and have access to stable internet connection to enable them to participate in online interactions; and
3. The following documentary requirements shall be scanned in one pdf file and shall be submitted to this office through email at **caraga@deped.gov.ph** and copy furnished the Human Resource Development Division at **hrdd_caraga@deped.gov.ph** on or before **October 26, 2020**:
 - a. Updated Personnel Data Sheet; and
 - b. Endorsement from the Schools Division Office through the Office of the Schools Division Superintendent

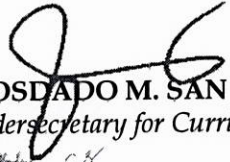

Leadership Program (SEA-SLP)

The Southeast Asian Minister of Education - Regional Center for Educational Innovation and Technology (SEAMEO INNOTECH) are allocating six (6) slots for school heads in DepEd for its Online Version of the Southeast Asian School Leadership Program (SEA-SLP) under the SEAMEO Educational Development Fund. Three (3) slots from primary schools and three (3) slots from secondary schools. The program will run from January 25 to March 5, 2021 and will receive an International Certificate of Completion upon complete submission of all the course requirements.

SEA-SLP is designed as a reflective learning journey that will provide our school leaders with the opportunity to reflect back on their experiences, claim the important lessons learned and integrate these into the regular school processes. The solutions which were proven effective need to be replicated, adapted and scaled-up for a stronger, more agile and resilient school system. By the end of this program, our school leaders will be able to confidently respond to this essential question: *What important lessons did we learn from this pandemic and how can we evolve as better school leaders than we were before this crisis?*

The program allocates (6) slots or the Philippines with the following qualification and corresponding documentary requirements:

a. Filipino citizen	1. Updated Personal Data Sheet 2. Endorsements from the head of office a. endorsement from the Schools Division Office through the Office of the SDS b. Nomination Letter from the Regional/Bureau Director or his/her duly authorized representative (thru the Regional HRDD Chiefs)
b. Must be 50 years old below	
c. At least five (5) years' experience as school head	
d. Must be computer literate and have access to stable Internet connection to enable them to participate in online interactions	
e. Able and willing to utilize course learning as well as share them with other school heads upon completion of the program	
f. Must hold a permanent appointment at the organization nominating him/her	
g. Must have no pending administrative and/or criminal case	
h. Must have a college degree and/or sufficient demonstrated ability and experience related/relevant to the course he/she is applying for	
i. Must have a good command of the English language (spoken and written)	
j. Must have professional development needs aligned with the KRAs of the organization	
k. Must have outstanding accomplishments related/leading to the program applying for	
l. Must have no pending nomination for scholarship in another program/course or have already rendered the required service obligation for a scholarship previously enjoyed	
m. Physically and mentally fit	

All required documents must be submitted via email at scholarships@deped.gov.ph on or before November 2, 2020.
