EXTENSION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ARABIC LANGUAGE AND
ISLAMIC VALUES EDUCATION (ALIVE) CURRICULUM FOR QUARTERS 3 & 4
FOR SCHOOL YEAR (SY) 2020-2021

1. Pursuant to Memorandum DM-OUCI-2020-325, the field is hereby informed on the extension of the implementation of the Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) Curriculum in the Third and Fourth Quarter of SY 2020-2021.
2. In the implementation of the ALIVE Curriculum for the remaining quarters, 40% will be allotted for Arabic Language and 60% for Islamic Values. The Arabic Language shall focus on the basic communication skills which shall be used as a medium to understand the depth and breadth of the teachings in Islamic Values.
3. In line with this, Schools Division Offices (SDOs) through the Division ALIVE Coordinators (DACs) are encouraged to revisit their identified Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs) to ensure that the current needs and situation of the learners within their specific contexts amidst COVID-19 pandemic are addressed. Electronic copy of the re-aligned MELCs based on the 60%-40% allocation shall be submitted to the Regional Office through the Regional ALIVE Coordinator at rhea.yparraguirre@deped.gov.ph on or before December 21, 2020.
4. Immediate dissemination and compliance to this Memorandum is highly desired.

In consideration of the current crisis where a new normal of learning has been engaged with to ensure that education continues at the height of challenges, it was decided to extend the implementation of the Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) Curriculum, specifically, in the third and fourth Quarter of SY 2020-2021. This is with reference to D.O. No. 41, s. 2017 entitled: *Policy Guidelines on Madrassah Education in the K to 12 Basic Education Program*.

In line with this, the regions are encouraged to choose and harvest the Learning Competencies (LCs) from the existing learning materials that will address the current needs and situation of the learners within their specific contexts.

As education continues in the midst of crisis, it is the priority of the Department of Education (DepEd) to take care of the well-being and mental health of its learners. Thus, in the implementation of the ALIVE curriculum for the remaining Quarters, 40% will be allotted for Arabic Language and 60% for Islamic Values. The Arabic Language shall focus on basic communication skills which shall be used as a medium to understand the depth and breadth of the teachings in Islamic Values. A separate Memorandum on the guidelines on the implementation of the 60%-40% scheme shall be released.

This undertaking is in response to the need to provide a relevant and flexible curriculum to the ALIVE learners to guarantee that education will continue and be provided especially amongst the marginalized groups and most vulnerable population.

Furthermore, this is to assure the implementers that the Enhanced K to 10 ALIVE Curriculum is a work in progress, hence, series of workshops are scheduled in November to ensure that it is available by SY 2021-2022. Alongside with this, shall be the issuance of the policy guidelines that shall set the standard for its implementation.
