ISSUES IN PNU MASTERAL AND DOCTORATE DEGREES UNDER
NEAP – RECOGNIZED PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT
PROGRAMS AND COURSES

1. This office received a letter from Director John Arnold S. Sienna of the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) regarding the enrollment of our public school teachers and school leaders to the masteral and doctorate degrees offered by the Philippine Normal University (PNU) under the NEAP – Recognized Professional Development Programs and Courses.
2. Some issues were raised by NEAP, to wit:
 - a. Fourteen percent (14%) of the listed participants have entered erroneous email addresses causing the PNU email to bounce back to the sender;
 - b. Over seventy-six percent (76.28%) of the listed participants have not replied to the email;
 - c. Forty (40) participants are registered to two courses simultaneously;
 - d. Eleven (11) participants have expressed their desire to transfer to another program;
 - e. Eleven participants (11) have signified their intention to withdraw; and
 - f. Seventeen participants were found to be not eligible to join the NEAP-PDP.
3. The NEAP recommends series of steps to follow to address the concerns stated above. These steps are outlined in the letter attached to this memo. An enclosure to the letter lists the name of the participants with remarkable concerns.
4. The division offices are likewise enjoined to seek other clarifications to possible remarkable concerns.
5. A template is likewise provided to facilitate the submission of names of possible additional/replacement participants. All corrections must be submitted on August 11, 2021. No request for extension shall be entertained beyond the



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aforementioned date since the official start of the PNU courses will begin on September 01, 2021.

Dear **Director Fetalvero**:

The National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) extends its warmest appreciation and gratitude for all the assistance you have provided in facilitating the enrolment of our public school teachers and school leaders to the masteral and doctorate degrees offered by the Philippine Normal University (PNU) under the NEAP-Recognized Professional Development Programs and Courses.

We wish to inform you that PNU has already embarked on the initial registration of all listed participants. An email has been sent to all registered school teachers and school leaders requiring them to accomplish an online registration form. Through this initial registration, it was found that:

1. Fourteen percent (14%) of the listed participants have entered erroneous email addresses causing the PNU email to bounce back to the sender;
2. Over seventy six percent (76.28%) of the listed participants have not replied to the email;
3. Forty (40) participants are registered to two courses simultaneously;
4. Eleven (11) participants have expressed their desire to transfer to another program;
5. Eleven (11) participants have signified their intention to withdraw; and,
6. Seventeen (17) participants were found to not be eligible to join the NEAP-PDP.

To address the issues stated above, we recommend the following:

For the emails that bounced back to the sender, we recommend that the registered email address be submitted and checked or an alternate email address be provided.



For those **participants who have not yet responded to the online registration**, we recommend that they be informed to check their emails and respond to the message sent by PNU.

For the **participants who are registered to two courses**, we recommend the Regional Office to confirm which course shall be pursued by the participant and that another participant be recommended to the vacated slot.

For the regions with **participants who have signified their desire to transfer** to another program, we recommend that the transfer be allowed only if there is a vacant slot in the intended course vacated by those who were deemed not eligible or by those who were registered simultaneously to two programs. **Otherwise, the transfer shall not be allowed.** The number of participants per course, per program is final and can no longer be adjusted. Likewise, transfers from masters to doctorate programs shall not be allowed.

For regions with **participants who have expressed their intent to withdrawing** from the program, the regions are advised to inform the concerned participant to submit a letter addressed to Undersecretary Nepomuceno A. Malaluan (Attention: Director John Arnold S. Siena), stating their reason for withdrawing to the program, and forward the same document to the Professional Development Division of NEAP (NEAP-PDD). Additionally, a replacement participant is to be recommended to the vacated slot.

Regions with listed **participants who are deemed "not eligible,"** are to submit the names of the replacement participants. Per DepEd Order No. 082, s. 2020, as a general eligibility for registration in NEAP-PDP, applicants must be public school teachers and school leaders.

To this end, we are again requesting your assistance in finalizing the names of the participants to the different PNU courses. Enclosed is the list of names of the participants with remarked concerns.

A template is likewise enclosed to facilitate the submission of the names of the additional participants. All corrections must be submitted **on or before 11 August 2021**. No requests for extension shall be entertained as we hope to submit the list of names as soon as possible in time for the 1 September 2021 official start of the PNU courses.

We are hoping for your usual support and assistance to the implementation of the NEAP-PDP.
