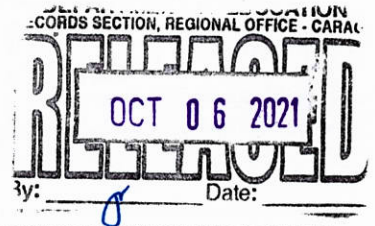

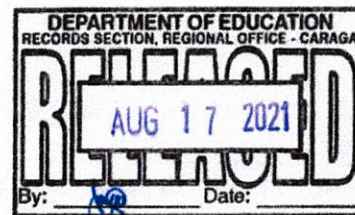

DEPED SKILLS DEMONSTRATION CONTEST (REGIONAL LEVEL)

1. Cognizant to DepEd Memorandum OUA-0821-0060 dated August 9, 2021, the Department of Education through the Bureau of Learners Support Services (BLSS-SSD)-School Sports Division (SSD) shall conduct the DepEd Sports Skills Demonstration Contest.

2. The contest aims to:

a. to provide the public-school student-athlete an opportunity and alternative venue to showcase their athletic talents in the absence of an organized school-based sports tournament due to covid 19 pandemic; and

b. provide financial assistance to the public schools particularly for their sports clubs and sports programs, by means of monetary prizes to be given to those winning participants.

3. The schedules of activities are the following:

Activities	Dates
Preliminary Planning/organizational meeting of SDO, SGOD-CID, Division Sports Officer and MAPEH Coordinators	3 rd week of August 2021
Division Sports Skills Competition	September 6-10, 2021
Submission of entries to the Regional Office.	September 13-17, 2021
Regional Sports Skills Competition	October 7, 2021
Submission of Entries to the National	October 18-22, 2021
National Sports Skills Competition	November 15-19, 2021

4. The Regional Sports Skills Contest shall be managed by ESSD and CLMD of the regional office with the technical supervision of the Regional Sports Officer (RSO) and MAPEH Supervisor, while the Division Sports Skills Contest shall be collaboratively managed by SGOD –CID with the technical supervision of the MAPEH Supervisor and the Division Sports Officer.

5. The SDO shall be responsible in identifying and selecting participating student-athletes from, at most, two (2) public secondary schools under its jurisdiction that would be in the best position to form, prepare, train a team, and exhibit the sports skills demonstration piece at their own choice of sports.



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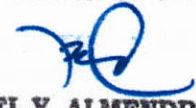


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6. The management of the Division and Regional Sports Skills Contest shall always observe prevailing risk level classification of its locality and the guidelines being enforced in accordance with the latest IATF guidelines.

AND CONTEST MECHANICS

I. Regional Management Committee:

CONTEST MECHANICS AND GUIDELINES

1. Participation

- a. Student-participants must be currently enrolled in SY 2021-2022 at any PUBLIC SECONDARY SCHOOL whose age must be 16-18 years old, physically in good condition and shall submit medical certificate and secure a parental/guardian consent.
- b. A team/group shall compose a minimum of six (6) and a maximum of twelve (12) members.
- c. Each SDO is allowed to field a maximum of two (2) teams from a separate public secondary school to perform a DISTINCT sports performance to the regional competition.

2. Composition of the contingent/delegation

- a. the team shall carry the name of the school;
- b. the team must comprise all male or all female or a combination of both male and female
- c. the team delegation shall compose of the following members:

Head of Delegation	-	SDO Representative
Team Manager	-	School Head/Principal
Coach/Trainer	-	Teacher Coach of the school
Choreographer	-	to be assigned
Medical Staff	-	Medical personnel of the school
Student-athletes	-	6-12 athletes
Support Staff-admin	-	selected school personnel

3. Contest Proper

The conduct of the DepEd Sports Skills Demonstration Contest at the Division, Regional and National Finals shall be through ONLINE MODALITY in compliance with IATF rules.

SDO/REGIONAL Contest

The DepEd SDO/RO organizing/technical working committee shall be given full discretion as to the contest format it will adopt depending on the number of entries, particularly those consisting of many districts/SDOs, it may conduct a qualifying or elimination round prior to regional finals. The top two performers in the SDO shall qualify to the regional finals, the top two performers in the regional finals shall qualify to the National finals.

NATIONAL FINALS Contest

The format of the National Finals shall be a single round performance of all the regional finalist, which will be judged by five (5) members of the board of judges based on the criteria set in these guidelines. The region with the best performance of sports skills shall be declared champion while there shall also be runners-up of up to 4th place.

4. Entries

- a. Entries containing the performance of team shall be video recorded in landscape mode, 1080p high definition, 100 MB file size, free from copy right rules, camera shall be place in a tripod for a steady shoot.
- b. Performances shall be done within the two (2) to three (3) minutes time limit;
- c. Performances shall be accompanied by any genre of music or any musical instrument of choice as background;
- d. Wearing of appropriate attire/uniform/costume is allowed; and
- e. Use of stage props, or any paraphernalia or apparatus shall be allowed provided it will not cause any danger or accident during the performance;
- f. Stunts and other forms of acrobatics such as pyramids, lifts, throws, among others that will cause any harm during the performance are highly discouraged.

5. Venues

- a. The school gym/ or barangay gym that has the space of 10 meters X 10 meters shall be utilized as venue for training, rehearsals, and actual shooting.
- b. If possible, it must be covered with rubber mats.
- c. It must have sufficient lighting system.
- d. Should have uniform layout backdrop design of the activity.

6. Judging

- a. There shall be five (5) members of the board of judges.
- b. Drawing of lots shall be conducted to determine the order of presentation of the video recorded performance.
- c. Each judge shall independently record his ratings on the judging sheet.
- d. After the performances of all the teams, the judges shall submit its final rating to the tabulation committee for consolidation and immediately announce the official results.
- e. The decision of the board of judges is final and executory, no protest will be entertained.
