To comply with the President's Veto Message¹, imposing a conditional implementation on Special Provision 21 of the General Appropriations Act (GAA) FY 2021, the grant of Transportation Allowances and Teaching Aid to ALS Teachers and the proscription against double compensation vis-à-vis the Special Hardship and Cash Allowances, this Office, through Memorandum OAGA-2021-0046, dated April 8, 2021, determined who among our ALS Teachers nationwide chose to receive the Transportation and Teaching Aid Allowances only or Special Hardship and Cash Allowances only.

The submitted number and list of names of ALS Teachers (Mobile Teachers and Full-Time DALSCs) by the Regional Offices except the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM), has been validated and certified by this Office to ensure that there is no double compensation and that only **ALS Teachers employed by DepEd** are eligible to receive said allowances.

Validated and certified list has been submitted to the Department of Budget and Management as the basis to release the fund.

The same list has been submitted to the Undersecretary for Finance and Undersecretary for Human Resource and Organizational Development as basis for the grant of Cash Allowance and Special Hardship Allowance.

The grant of Transportation and Teaching Aid Allowances for this year shall be guided by the existing DepEd Policies:

1. **DepEd Order No. 59, s. 2016** - Amendment to DepEd Order Nos. 59, s.2012; 19, s.2013; 17, s. 2014; and 17, s. 2015
2. **DepEd Order No. 50, s. 2017** - Amendment and Additional Information to DepEd Order Nos. 58 and 59, s.2012.

The grant of Cash Allowance and Special Hardship Allowance shall be guided by:

1. **DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2021** – Supplemental Guidelines on the Grant of Cash Allowance to Teachers
2. **DepEd Order No. 39, s. 2021** – Guidelines on the Provision of Special Hardship Allowance for Public School Teachers.

The Sub-Allotment Release Order (Sub-ARO) intended for the grant of Transportation and Teaching Aid Allowances to ALS Teachers shall be released to the Regional Offices upon the release of fund from DBM to DepEd Central Office.
