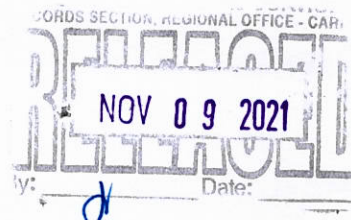

The implementation of various distance learning delivery modalities (DLDMs) covered in the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP) has made learning continuity feasible for school year 2020-2021 amidst the threat and uncertainties brought about by COVID-19 pandemic. In this regard, the Department of Education's Bureau of Learning Delivery - Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD) is conducting a research to better understand how these learning delivery modalities were operationalized in field offices, with the goal of using this information to inform policy review and formulation for teaching and learning.

To facilitate the data collection process, all regional offices are enjoined to disseminate the online survey questionnaires via Google Forms to randomly selected participants composed of teachers, learners, parents, school heads, and regional, division, and district supervisors. Their participation is voluntary. They will receive thru email the link to their online survey questionnaire.

Annex B: GUIDELINES FOR SAMPLING PROCEDURE

1. Sixty percent (60%) of the total number of Schools Division Offices (SDOs) in every region has been randomly selected to participate in the **Actual Data Gathering of the Online Survey Questionnaires** relative to the **Implementation of Distance Learning Delivery Modalities (DLDMs) for SY 2020-2021**.
2. There will be three schools randomly selected per SDO. There will be a total of one hundred and thirty-four (134) Divisions who will participate in the Actual Data Gathering.
3. Each division will randomly select 3 schools composing of 1 elementary school, 1 junior high school, and 1 senior high school. In the selection of schools, all distance learning delivery modalities shall be represented, and the type of school and school size shall be considered whether Central School, Monograde, Multigrade, Last Mile School; and if it is small with less than 440 learners, medium with 441-840 learners, large with 841-1,240 learners, and very large with 1,241 and above learners.
4. There will be 3 participating schools in each identified SDO-respondent, with a total of four hundred and two (402) school-respondents for the Actual Data Gathering.
5. The target participants per region will be composed of the following:
 - a. 1 Regional EPS
 - b. At least 1 Division EPS/PSDS from each of the identified SDOs
 - c. At least 3 School Heads per identified SDO-participant in that region
 - d. At least 30 Teachers per identified SDO-participant in that region (10 Teachers per school x 3 schools per Division)
 - e. At least 30 Learners per identified SDO-participant in that region (10 Learners per school x 3 schools per Division)
 - f. At least 15 Parents per identified SDO-participant in that region (5 Parents per school x 3 schools per Division)
6. Each school shall randomly select teachers, learners, and parents that will represent across all grade levels. Schools and SDOs may use any strategy or tool to randomly identify their respondents.
7. The SDOs will prepare the list of their identified schools and their contact details using the attached template enclosed in this document. The accomplished template shall be sent to wanny.santos@deped.gov.ph using the following format as the email subject:

8. A documentation (i.e.: Zoom recording, pictures, etc.) of how the pilot school respondents were identified by the division shall be sent to the region and the Central Office through the email rosalie.bongon@deped.gov.ph.
9. All regional and select division research supervisors/coordinators are requested to facilitate the data collection process and communicate with BLD-TLD for any concerns.
