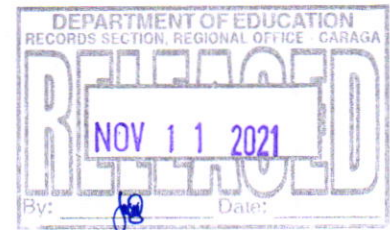

The allocation of SPED items shall depend on the number of qualified applicants and the number of enrolled Learners with Difficulties in the Learner's Information System (LIS) and in the Enhanced Basic Education Information System (EBEIS).

 - Education- Bachelor's Degree in Education with the minimum of 18 units of SPED at the graduate level of Undergraduate course on Bachelor of Special Needs Education (BSNed);
 - Eligibility- appropriate civil service eligibility (PBET, LET, Teacher, A 1080);
 - Experience- 3 years' experience in providing educational services to children with disabilities either in Self- Contained or Inclusive classes; and
 - Performance Rating- very satisfactory for the last three years.

- **Performance Rating** - Very Satisfactory for the last three years.
