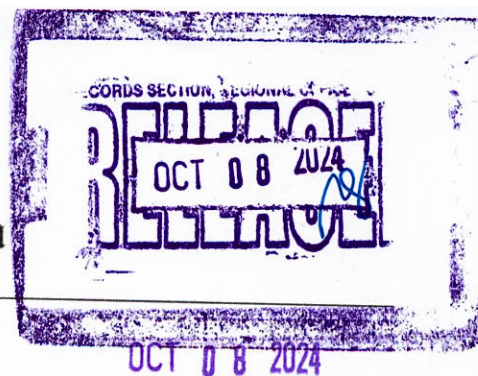

FIELD MONITORING ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MADRASAH EDUCATION PROGRAM (MEP)

1. In reference to the letter signed by Director IV Leila P. Areola dated October 4, 2024, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learning Delivery - Student Inclusion Division (BLD-SID), will conduct a three-day field monitoring on the implementation of the Madrasah Education Program (MEP) on October 9-11, 2024.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. gather evidence-based data from MEP implementers in schools,
 - b. ensure the effective and efficient implementation of the program,
 - c. ensure the increase in learners' enrollment, and
 - d. provide technical assistance to Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) teachers and instructional leaders.
3. The monitoring team will be composed of Mr. Nicanor M. San Gabriel Jr. and Ms. Armi S. Victor, Supervising Education Program Specialists from the Central Office, along with the Regional Madrasah Education Program Coordinator (RMEPC), and the Division Madrasah Education Program Coordinator (DMEPC).
4. The team will conduct classroom observations, data collection, focus group discussions (FGDs), and interviews with select ALIVE teachers, learners, and school heads in the implementing schools.
5. Target participants include ALIVE teachers, learners, school heads, and other relevant stakeholders in schools implementing the Madrasah Education Program within the Schools Divisions of Butuan City, Surigao City, and Tandag City.
6. All expenses incurred during this activity will be charged to MEP Funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
